5. Applicant must be a Junior member of the North Bay Golf & Country Club in good standing who demonstrates good sportsmanship, good citizenship and leadership along with a strong passion for the game of golf.
6. All monetary disbursement must be applied to post secondary education expenses.
7. Successful recipient(s) will be announced at the Bill Morland Men's Invitational.
